2016-2018 ADMINISTRATION

The Charlotte Emerson Brown Award for Excellence in State Leadership was created to recognize exemplary service of State Presidents to their State Federations and GFWC. The 2016-2018 honorees will be recognized during the GFWC Annual Convention in St. Louis, Missouri in June 2018.

To be eligible for this award, each of the following criteria must be met by the State President:

Attend the 2017 and 2018 GFWC Annual Conventions, 2016 and 2017 GFWC Region Conferences, and the August 2016 and 2017 GFWC Board of Directors Meetings to represent their state federation. Or, if attendance was prevented by extenuating circumstances, provide an explanation:

- Submit the March 15, 2017 and 2018 Statistical Form.
- Submit the April 15, 2017 and 2018 Annual Report.
- Submit the April 15, 2018 one hundred-fifty (150) word Administration Report.

Also, check all the following which apply:

- Enhance the State Federation's communication via newsletter, magazine, or email sent to all members/clubs at least three times a year.
- State is represented at both the 2017 and 2018 LEADS seminars held in conjunction with the GFWC Annual Conventions. Provide names of LEADS attendees in your narrative.
- Hold a state LEADS seminar to boost state leadership skills.
- Hold a state LEADS seminar both years of the administration.
- Invite a GFWC Officer to attend a state meeting or event during the 2016-2018 GFWC Administration.
- Invite a GFWC officer both years of the administration.
- Strive to visit as many clubs as feasibly possible.
- Attain an increase in attendance at State conventions and/or other state meetings during the 2016-2018 administration, based on registration figures.
- Show an increase in total dues paying membership during the administration.
- Show an increase in number of clubs during this administration.
