## April is Sexual Assault Awareness and Prevention Month

According to the Rape, Abuse, and Incest National Network (RAINN), an American is sexually assaulted every 98 seconds, but only six out of every 1,000 perpetrators serve time in prison. The Center for Disease Control and Prevention defines sexual violence as "any sexual activity where consent is not freely given," including completed or attempted sex acts where the victim does not consent and/or is unable to consent. Sexual violence also includes unwanted sexual contact, as well as verbal sexual harassment.

April is Sexual Assault Awareness and Prevention Month, and the National Sexual Violence Resource Center has chosen "Engaging New Voices" as this year's theme. ## Proving Dogs Are Man's Best Friend

Imagine not being able to open a door, flip a light switch, or pick up a set of keys without asking for help. Now imagine the relief and self-confidence a person with a disability will feel when a Canine Companions for Independence (CCI) dog helps her with these tasks.

After envisioning the quality of life improvements that could be achieved for her friend's daughter with cerebral palsy, GFWC Texas President Patti Poe became an active supporter of CCI. The Special Project for President Poe's administration will be raising funds to provide service dogs to not only children, but adults and veterans as well.

Assistance dogs are different from typical family pets in that they receive extensive and specialized training. Volunteer puppy raisers provide basic coaching and socialization for the first 18



## Book News

Ada Calhoun, winner of the 2015 Jane Cunningham Croly Award for Excellence in Journalism Covering Issues of Concern to Women, will be releasing a new book on May 16. *Wedding Toasts I'll Never Give* is being published by W.W. Norton & Company and available for preorder through [Amazon.com](http://Amazon.com). The book has received wonderful reviews. *Publishers Weekly* describes the book this way, "A humorous, realistic, and loving look at marriage....Each essay mixes components of memoir and self-help, drawing on insight from Calhoun's own marriage as well as the wise thoughts of clergymen and lessons learned from long-married

months of a dog's training. The dogs, typically Labrador Retrievers or Golden Retrievers, are then given an additional six to nine months of instruction at a professionally staffed training center. It is at the training facility where dogs learn the up to 50 advanced commands that will support their work as assistance dogs. The instruction and lifetime support of the each assistance dog cost \$50,000.

Despite the large fees incurred for training, CCI does not charge for assistance dogs or the ongoing maintenance the organization provides. CCI is a nonprofit funded through private donations from individuals, corporations, and organizations such as GFWC.

Texas clubwomen have already raised \$2,500 from a dog photo contest at the fall board meeting and various other activities. President Poe expects DogFest Walk n' Roll Austin to be the state's largest fundraiser and hopes to earn enough to fully fund one assistance dog at the event.
