## GUIDELINES

- Clubs completing an application must hold active membership (per capita dues paying) in their State Federations and in the General Federation of Women's Clubs.
- Funding must be used to replenish libraries that have been affected by natural and manmade disasters.
- The libraries that receive these gifts need to be within the community or communities that your club membership serves.
- The application must include an impact statement, photos and/or news article showing the damage and destruction, and letter from affected library.
- Clubs must complete an evaluation, which will be included with the grant check if the club application is approved.
